MISSION UPDATE

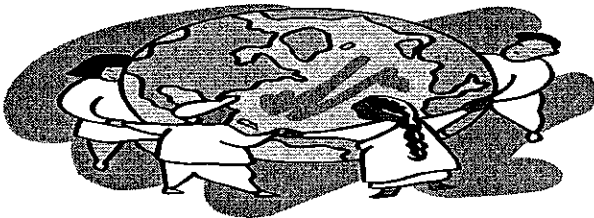

Food Pantry and Shoebox Ministries

Food Pantry is a vital ministry in our church. We provide much needed food to our community members in crisis. Food Pantry Sunday is always the first Sunday of the month, but we accept donations any time throughout the year. The Food Pantry is low on canned meats, peanut butter and jelly, soups, and boxed and bagged non-perishable items such as stuffing, potatoes, pastas, rice, cereals, gravy packets, etc. This program could not continue without the support of our congregation. Thank you to all who give to the pantry, no matter how small or large and no matter how often.

Our Church participates in a donation program called the **Shoebox Ministries**. After the items are collected and the shoeboxes filled, they are given to the needy in our area.

Donations can be placed in the Narthex or next to the Sunday School Bulletin Board located in the Education Building all through the year.

Thank you for your donations and support to this very worthy cause. Suggestions for items to fill the boxes are listed below, if you can think of anything else that you would like to donate please do so.

Things needed for the boxes: **Men:** shampoo, conditioner, small tissue packs, lip balm, combs, hand lotion, toothpaste, deodorant, razors. **Women:** shampoo, conditioner, small tissue packs, combs/brushes, hand & body lotion, toothpaste, lip balm, body powder, deodorant, razors. **Children:** shampoo, conditioner, lip balm, small tissue packs, combs/brushes, toothpaste, school supplies (pencils, crayons, rulers, small notepads, safety scissors). **Baby:** shampoo, baby wipes, powder, pacifier, bibs, bottles, rattles, sipper cups, Onesies, disposable diapers.

Graduating Confirmands Confirm Faith



On Sunday, October 4th at the 11AM Service, this year's graduating confirmands, Mike Marsh, John Myers, Emma Riemer, Karley Sullivan, will be confirming their faith. What this means is that these young adults will confirm in public the gift that has been given to them when they were baptized. They will be giving a testimony to what God has done for them.

As children, their parents brought them to the altar and acknowledged the gift of salvation that God gives to all who come to Him, even little babies. In Baptism, they were sealed by the Holy Spirit and marked with the cross of Christ forever.

Now as adults, they will acknowledge the gift of salvation. Their parents will no longer do it for them. We pray that you can be encouraged by them as they give testimony to the faith in which they were baptized.

Let these new members be a testimony to the never ending love of God which has sustained his people throughout the generations. And may you in turn do the same for others.

The youth and adults who attended the 2009 National Youth Gathering in New Orleans would like to thank everyone who had any part in sending them on this trip. New Orleans was a remarkable city. The people were gracious and ever so accommodating as 37,000 Lutherans descended on them for five days. The Lutheran Youth received a thank you from the Mayor of New Orleans and a greeting and thank you letter from President Obama. We were told that as a group we accomplished more in the five days of volunteer work than had been done in the three years since Katrina. There were waves of Lutheran youth working all over the city; building levees, painting houses, cleaning cemeteries, and helping people. Our youth mission was at an Elementary school in Jefferson Parish. Some of us painted a hallway, and some of us worked in a reading class with children. The average student in New Orleans reads two grade levels lower than the grade they are presently enrolled. Our task was to help them strengthen their reading skills by reading with them, working with educational games and sharing our reading skills. We also donated books to their classrooms. We packed 20 handmade quilts from our Quilters Guild and delivered them to the Liberty House in New Orleans. The Liberty House is a mission for single mothers and their children. As you can see, we had a packed week in New Orleans. We will be planning a dinner and presentation for the fall so watch for details. Thank you again for helping us to bless others!

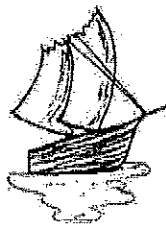
